Developing campuses as innovation hubs by creating better urban environment for businesses and residents



- How about the green spaces around the campus? Bike lanes? Safe walkways for pedestrians?
- How do we mitigate the expected negative effect of increased traffic, to ensure resilient, eco-friendly and livable environment?
