
The Substantiation is: The UL model of excellence, the UL strategic realization plan of the UL Library's strategic activities during 2010-2020.








The total situation at UL we have:

Conclusions

- 1. The Natural Sciences block lacks only 12% of necessary informational resources.
- 2. The block of Humanities lacks 33% of necessary resources.
- 3. The availability of resources is growed up in comparison to the simalar research of the 2011(there were 23 studio programs).

What will be the next?

The Aim - system where the descriptions of the studio courses include the only those primary information resources which are included into the library's stock.

The stages of our activities:

- 1. The detailed methodology was worked out.
- 2. The research results were given to the heads of programs.
- 3. The pilot project will be started at one of the faculties in autumn.
- 4. The necessary informational resources will be added in the stock.
- UL Library sends information about new obtained issues to the academic staff once a month.
