The range of books by content is rather diverse

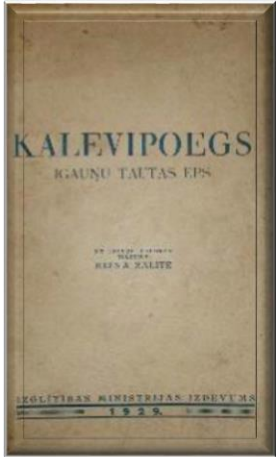
The collection volume - 4872 titles in 9322 coppies

The collection is supplemented

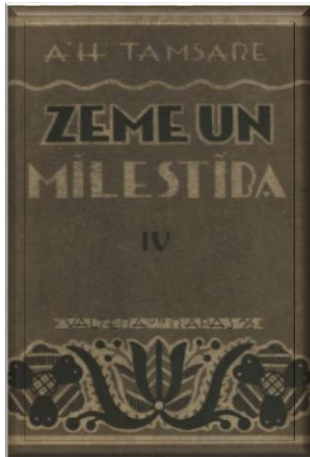

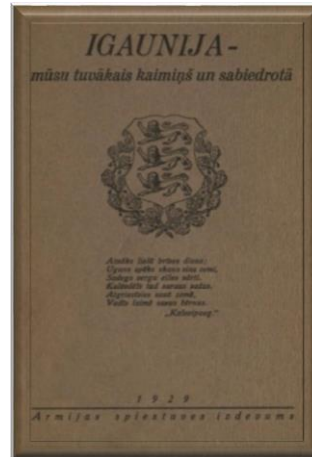

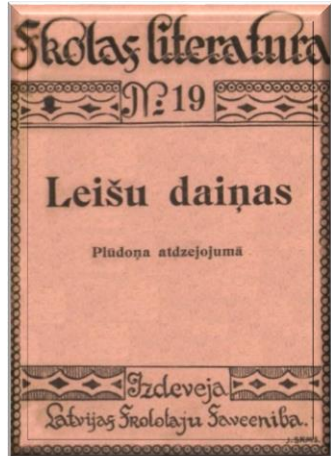

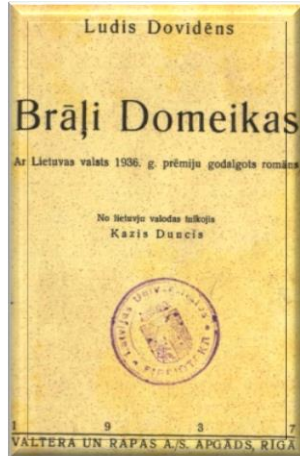

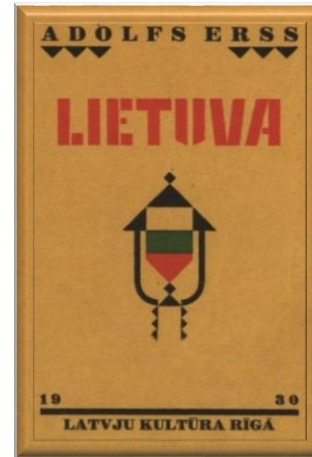

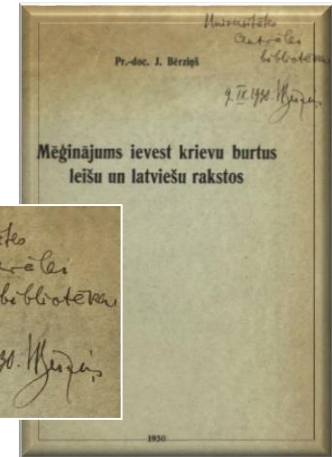

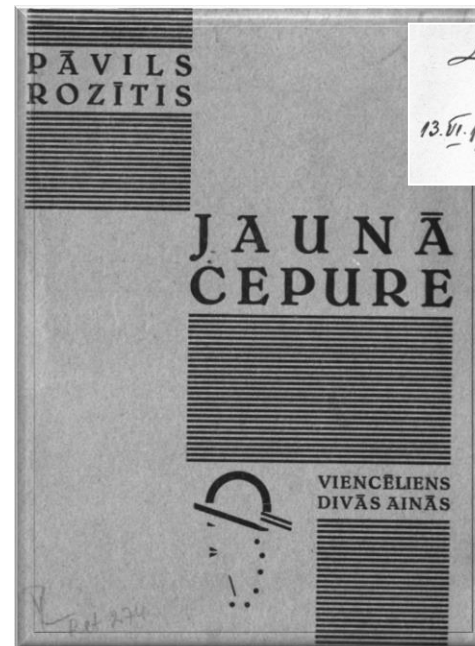

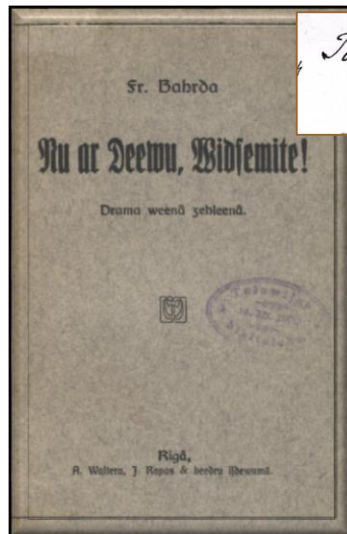

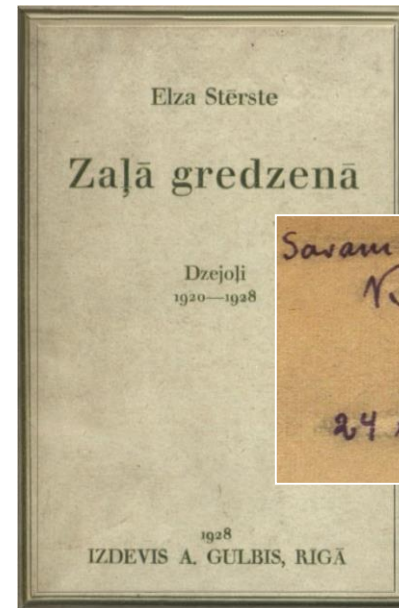

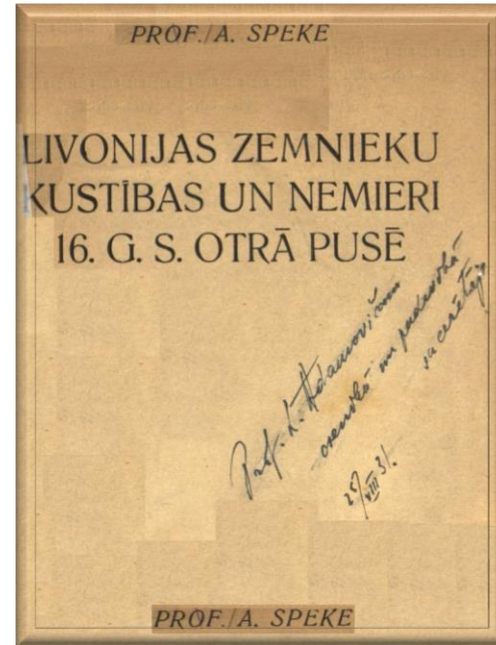

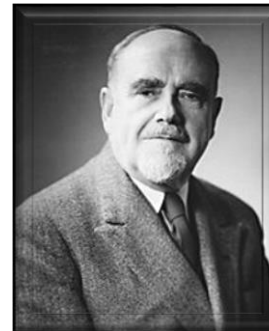

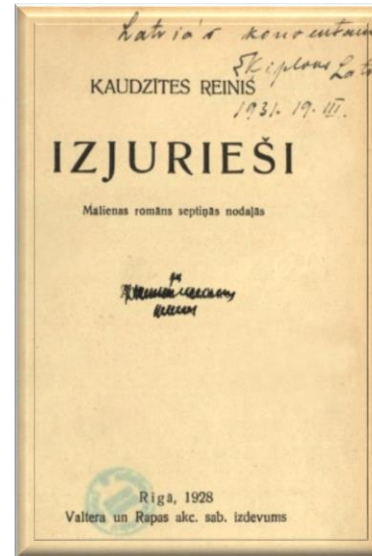

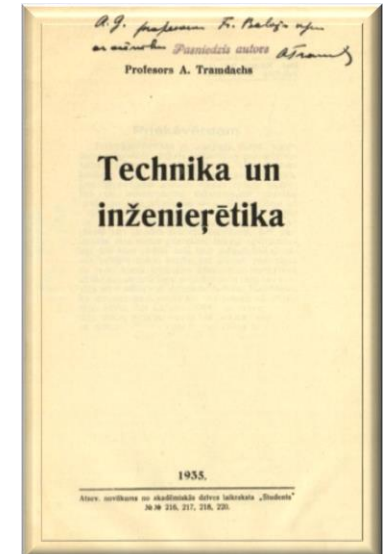
